**Blytheswood Boxes** are due on the 30<sup>th</sup> of this month, please speak with Morag McPetrie for more.

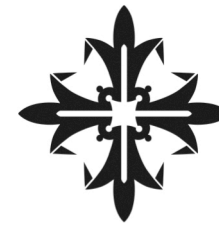
